 by us the subscribers a Committee for the Town of Groenid from
 the Bloods farm to Groenid of two rods wide beginning at Groenid
 bounds near James Bloods Dwelling house and is Described
 by marks on the Easterly and Southerly side of said way or
 ways the first mark is a black oak tree from thence to a
 white oak, and thence to a white oak, from thence to a Red
 oak from thence to a walnut tree, at Capt Wilsons Easterly Cor-
 ner, then we begun at the Southerly corner of Jonathian Bloods
 farm at a heap of stones and Layd out a two Rod way with
 marks on the easterly side, the first of which is a white oak
 tree marked from thence to a black oak marked. thence
 to a black oak thence to a black oak thence to a white
 oak thence to a white oak and then to a white oak marked
 and thence to a black oak and thence to the afore said walnutt
 tree at Capt Wilsons Corner, then Running two Rods wide
 on Capt Wilsons Land till it Coms to Gershom Healds
